SECRETARY'S REPORT

MOTION to accept July minutes, unanimous.

CORRESPONDENCE

1st Baptist Church – Received a request for facility use from the church. Sent in response for use on 1st Thursday of each month at 7:30pm.

CHARIHO Field Requests – Received approval to use fields from M-F, 5pm to dusk each evening. Also received word that the field behind Vo-Tech can no longer be used there is a wind project that will be installed and kids may get hurt on guide wires.

Hopkinton Field Request – Received approval to use fields from M-F, 5pm to dusk each evening at Ashaway and Crandell Fields.

URI Night – Met with Rob Czonka and R. O'Connor and discussed URI / CYSA partnership. URI Men's Soccer Night will host a CYSA night 16 October. Details will be forwarded later.

TREASURER'S REPORT

MOTION to accept July report, unanimous.

DIRECTOR OF COMPETITIVE

Karen reported that all of the competitive rosters sent in to SRI. NE Revolution Game has been set up for the 17th of October details to be posted on CYSA website. Spring Competitive Tryouts will be held the same day as Family Day 24th October.

DIRECTOR OF COACHES

Ed reported that U-12B still need Jorge Gomez to register on line, other than that all coaching slots taken. Only 1 U8 roster still not picked up by coach. ***Ed took an action to send out a mass e-mail to all coaches for the uniform pick up night on Wed September 2nd from 6-8 in the front of CHARIHO HS. He will also provide a copy of the updated trifold for the parents and scorecards for the coaches. Mark took an action to get the picture forms for the coach's packets.***

DIRECTOR OF REFEREES

Norm would like to get 3 volunteers for the Referee Academy for the U10 and U12 groups there will be 2 sessions at no cost. The referee assignments will be going over to a new system this year.

Norm also presented a new 10 game schedule for the recreational league. It was decided to hold Family Day on October 24th and Friendship Game Day on October 31st.

DIRECTOR OF EQUIPMENT

Jeff reported that all but 4 have their equipment. The teams without equipment should contact Jeff directly to set up a pick up time. Jeff has ordered new size 4 / 5 balls, along with flags, ball bags and disk cones.

DIRECTOR OF FIELDS

Jeff C. reported that the port-a-pottys will be delivered first week in September. Field layout will remain the same as last year. Layout will occur the week before Labor Day.

DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATIO N

There are 484 registered for recreation and 16 unpaid to date (down from 80 last month). 10 partial scholarships were given out this year. Lisa would like us to emphasize that rosters cannot be changed during the coaches meeting at the beginning of the year. *It was agreed that the registrar can get folks that are not board members to help with team assignments as long as they register as volunteers and are not given personal information on the children. Jeff StOnge will help with the registration payment process and the birth certificates for new players.* It was suggested that we add one additional player to the U6 rosters, we will question the coaches at the end of the year to see what they think. Chris /Lisa will look into adding Jeff S. and Dennis to the database access list.

U19 group only 4 registered, last year we had 8. Look inot refunding the players their \$\$\$\$. If they would like to still play pick up games can be held and the players would only pay the \$10 insurance fee, players to register right on the field with paper forms.

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC RELATIONS

We have 78 sponsors as of today. This is a good number for this year. Bill waived the fee for the Umbrella Factory this year, they could not afford to give, based on 28 years of continuous giving. We also received \$1000 for the TOP Soccer program. Bonnie Ripstien will coordinate will Bill on new equipment for the program. Bill would like to see the TOPs soccer program increase from 10 to 12 kids to around 25 in the near future.

DIRECTOR OF FUND RAISING

Sue reported that Uniroyal has a promotional program for rural soccer programs.
