## **SECRETARY'S REPORT**

**MOTION** to accept June minutes, unanimous.

## **CORRESPONDENCE**

Town Budgets – Charlestown approved \$250 in their budget for CYSA. Richmond approved \$750 in their budget.

## **TREASURER'S REPORT**

**MOTION** to accept June report, unanimous. Sherri Jackson absent. Need to rectify \$564 double payment (both comp and rec). *Post meeting note league fees were split evenly across rec and competitive.*

## **DIRECTOR OF COMPETITIVE**

Ed V reported events from the SuperLiga meeting: Problems with identifying multiple coaches during games. New SuperLiga handbook will be posted on the WWW. *Make sure that no competitive games are scheduled for Earth Day (Sep 18, 19).* Talk of automatically adjusting team division assignments the following season based on previous scoring results and record. Our \$500 Spring bond was returned in full to CYSA one of a few clubs that did not receive a coaching infraction.

## **DIRECTOR OF COACHES**

50 coaches have registered. Of these we do not know how many are for competitive league. 13 signed up as assistant, but will become a coach if need be. There needs to be 64 total coaches based on team assignments. *Ed to advertise a coaches meeting on July 27th.* Dan O talked with Colin Redhead and the Xara coach's training sessions, scheduled for 4 August.

## **DIRECTOR OF REFEREES**

Will try to continue with the referee academy. Talked about rec refereeing protocol.

## **DIRECTOR OF EQUIPMENT**

Going to give out the Dynamite Xara balls either on July 27 or first week in August. Will get them from Elmwood Sports. Christine will order them. Leray will hand out equipment to the coaching meeting Jeff D. will be on vacation that week.

## **DIRECTOR OF FIELDS**

Jeff C. reported that the port-a-potty has been removed. Field layout will remain the same as last year. Layout will occur the week before Labor Day.

## **DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATION**
