DIRECTOR OF COMPETITIVE

DIRECTOR OF COACHES

Mike Prevy can do training for Y1, Y2, Y3 after the season is over. E License course in Fall River. In order for a D License course within Chariho, need 10-15 candidates and a large facility. *Ed to follow up with Barbara to find out what the real story is on this aspect of the risk management program.*

DIRECTOR OF REFEREES

DIRECTOR OF EQUIPMENT

DIRECTOR OF FIELDS

Paint bill has arrived for \$2100. Need to order a third port-a-john and place down by U6 fields, they were very popular last weekend. Field work was completed on September 30th Wednesday, some holes were filled on but there were very few volunteers.

DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATION

Registration has been closed out. Question about whether computer based registration is still possible. Registration via paper for any U19 walk-ons will be allowed. Do to low numbers in the U19 category CYSA will cover their registration cost. Will refund money for those that already paid.
